Thank you for taking an interest in the Club, of which we are very proud. Weymouth Golf Club is a Private Members' Club, which was founded in 1909. We hope that you will find all the relevant information you may need in this leaflet.

### **GOLF LESSONS**

If you are a beginner you may want to consider taking lessons with your Club Professional, Mr Dan Carter. He can be contacted on 01305 750831 and will inform you of opportunities for learning the game. Young people aged 6 or over can also apply, with a parent or guardian, for golf lessons and special sessions are held for them.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

Junior Membership is available from 10 years old and upwards (although, exceptionally, young players may be accepted from 8 years of age). When you feel ready please ask your parent/guardian to contact us and we will arrange a short meeting in order to discuss all matters relating to membership.

We currently have a few spaces available for Adult Playing Members and if you would like to join then you will need to complete one of our application forms, which are available from the office. If you are coming from another Club please provide us with their name and address and attach a copy of your current Handicap Certificate.

Social Membership is also available.

### **WHAT WILL IT COST?**

New Member Rate for the first 4 years £840.25

The current year's Annual Subscriptions are:

**£740.00** for members aged 27 years plus

**£555.00** for age 24 to 26

**£370.00** for age 21 to 23

**£222.00** for age 18 to 20

Juniors Annual Subscriptions are:

**£92.50** for age under 18

See Club Rule 26

Academy Members Subscriptions are over 18 £57.25

Country Membership is available to bona fide playing members of a Golf Club and permanently resident more than 30 miles from Weymouth. Membership is valid for up to 15 rounds of golf in any one subscription year.

Annual Subscription is **£273.25**

Flexi Membership

An annual membership of **£343.20** with a £10 per round weekdays and £15 at weekends per round charge.

All playing members also pay Affiliation Fees to the Dorset County and English Golf Unions totalling **£17.70** (Ladies pay **£21.00**).

All Adult players pay a **£15.00** Development Fund Charge for the year of 2019/2020.

Weymouth Golf Club offers an Affordable Membership scheme on a case by case basis. This scheme is aimed at new members on Low or Modest incomes. Any prospective candidate would need to demonstrate they match the Golf Clubs criteria to be eligible to join this category of membership.

The annual price for an Affordable Membership is £490. This would entitle a member to play Sunday all day and from 12 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

Any person wishing to join the club under this scheme should contact the Golf Club Office to understand eligibility and obtain an application form.

Social Membership costs only **£30.00** per year including VAT

Smartcards are available for a returnable deposit of **£5.00**. These can be "topped up" in the bar and offers 20% discount on most bar purchases and 10% discount on some restaurant purchases.

### **HOW CAN I PAY?**

Annual subscriptions are payable by Direct Debit and may in the case of Junior and Adult Playing Membership be spread over quarterly or monthly amounts. There is no charge for a single annual payment, but spread payments carry an administration charge of £35.00 adult (£15.00 junior).

### **MEMBERSHIP FACTS**

The Club's management policy is decided by an annually elected Committee and the implementation of that policy is the responsibility of the Manager.

We believe that the success of our Club is in its friendly approach and also in its insistence upon member's adherence to the Rules of the Club as well as the Rules of Golf.

Our relaxed approach is possible due to the acceptance, by the members, that standards need to be maintained. There are Dress Codes for the Clubhouse and Course and all members adhere to them.
